### Superintendent Update

Here comes the heat! As we enter July and August, our cool season turfgrass will be at peak stress. High temperatures bring a long list of problems. From drought and turf disease pressure, to compaction issues and warm season weed pressure. Cart traffic stress will show quickly, so try to scatter instead of driving in the same areas.

We aerated some of our tees again recently to relieve compaction and allow better water movement through the soil. We also continue to add soil/seed to areas on the back 9. Wetting agents will be applied to help with water retention, please be patient with the grounds staff as their watering routine picks up. Let's have a good summer, enjoy the course!
