### Superintendent Update

As I look back at the 2018 season, we learned a lot. Good rain gear is priceless, and Mother Nature can be cruel. All joking aside, I think we received more rain this year than the last four years combined. The course battled continuous heavy rain all season long with high temperatures mixed in. Constant soil saturation mixed with summertime heat destroys the turf's root system. Not ideal growing conditions.

Obviously we were not the only club that dealt with this relentless weather. But enough gloom and doom!

As turf thinned out, we over seeded with new varieties. These varieties have better traffic tolerance while needing less input (fertility and water). The club purchased an aerification attachment and we've been aerating tees, fairways and rough areas. This relieves one of our biggest issues: soil compaction. It allows the soil to drain and gets oxygen to the turf's root system.

We are also starting a drainage project on numerous holes around the course. This will improve day to day playability and also reduce cart restrictions. I am excited for the 2019 season. I hope to see you on the course!
